Personal Information Collection Agreement

This Agreement is established when the Overseas Compatriot Culture and Education Foundation (hereinafter referred to as the Foundation) needs to collect the signer's personal information and use it based on the contents of this Agreement for the purpose of the performance of an official duty or fulfillment of a legal obligation during the period of organizing the 3rd Ten Outstanding Overseas Compatriot Youth Award of Republic of China in 2021. In order to protect your rights and help you understand how we collect, use and protect your personal information, you should read carefully the contents of this Agreement.

I. The Scope of Use of the Signer's Personal Information:

This Foundation will collect, process and use your personal information in accordance with the provisions of the Personal Information Protection Act if it is necessary to obtain your personal information for handling the following matters:

- (1) The written review of the 4rd Ten Outstanding Overseas Compatriot Youth Award of Republic of China in 2021.
- (2) The awarding activities for the 4rd Ten Outstanding Overseas Compatriot Youth Award of Republic of China in 2021.

II. The Collection and Use of the Signer's Personal Information:

- (1) Based on the preceding paragraph, the following personal information is required to provide with: name, date of birth, contact information and other information that can identify you personally, directly or indirectly.
- (2) You are free to choose whether or not to provide the Foundation with your personal information. If the personal information you provide is incomplete, the service offered by the Foundation may thus discontinue or fail to achieve perfection.
- (3) The information is only available to the Foundation or third parties for the above purposes in the form of electronic files or papers kept in the Foundation within the scope permitted by the Act.
- (4) In accordance with the provision of Item 2, Article 8 of the Personal Information Protection Act, if it is one of the following matters, the Foundation may collect and use your personal information without notice.
 1. A notice is waived in accordance with the law.
 2. The collection of personal information is necessary for the performance of an official duty or fulfillment of a legal obligation.
 3. Informing that the performance of an official duty is obstructed.

4. Informing that the significant interests of third parties are damaged.
5. The signer did not inform the information knowingly.

III. The Period Allowing to Use the Personal Information

You agree that the Foundation uses your personal information in the period from the date of your consent to:

- (1) The date on which you request this Foundation to stop using your personal information.
- (2) The date on which the purpose stated in Article 1 ceases to exist.
- (3) Other time limits that must be kept in accordance with the law.

IV. the Rights of the Signer

When the Foundation uses your personal information, you may exercise the following rights in accordance with Article 3 of the Personal Information Protection Act:

- (1) Any inquiry or request for a review of the personal information.
- (2) Any request to make duplications of the personal information.
- (3) Any request to supplement or correct the personal information.
- (4) Any request to discontinue collection, processing and use of personal information.
- (5) Any request to delete the personal information.

When the Foundation retains your personal information, based on the provisions of the Personal Information Protection Act of the People's Republic of China, you can exercise your rights and interests through E-mail or in writing, except for compliance with the Personal Data Protection Act and other relevant laws.
